

Flagpole Photographers finished the year with a superb showing in the interclub competitions. The club was the recipient of a gold medal as the Color Interclub Competition Winner for 2011–12!

Ercole Gaudioso received an honorable mention in the Spring 2012 Interclub Electronic Competition Pictorial Class B for his image "The Horse Farm".

And in the 2012 NECCC Summer Conference Competition, Anne Eigen was awarded an honorable mention for her digital submission "Green Heron in Flight".

KEN GRAFF'S PROGRAM NIGHT

Accomplished photographer and educator Ken Graff presented at the final program meeting of the year. Graff's program focused on his travels to Viet Nam in January of this year and emphasized that preparation is key for travel photography.

Starting with his camera bag, Graff listed all the photographic equipment and supplies he brought as well as what he left at home. Seeing backup as all-important, Graff brought two of almost everything including cameras, batteries and chargers, and adapters. Added to the list were "lots of memory cards" and plastic bags to protect camera equipment from the elements.

Graff believes that having a DSLR with a 70-300mm zoom on a Black Rapid strap and a small mirrorless camera on a wrist strap with an 18-55mm wide angle covered all photographic contingencies.

Supporting his equipment preparation was his strategy for backing up and storage of images. He believes it is important to have at least two places to store images. This ensures that in the event of a catastrophe, all photos would not be lost. Graff's storage took three forms: external hard drives, iPad and online storage. Graff found that the internet was in wide use in Viet Nam and he had no difficulty getting online, sometimes borrowing a computer.

Another area of preparation for Graff was shooting RAW. Graff did a lot of shooting in difficult conditions such as through tour bus windows where lighting was not always optimal and movement required high shutter speeds and ISOs. By shooting RAW, Graff was able to correct for exposure and excess noise with post-production software such as Lightroom.
