# Art Vaughan, HonNEC

With over 40 years in photography, Art Vaughan applied his skills professionally with over 25 years at Bell Laboratories focusing on analytical industrial photography for microcircuit development.

A dedicated member of the photography community since joining the Merrimack Valley Camera Club in 1985, he served extensively as its president and print competition chairman. He is also involved with the Massachusetts Camera Naturalists and the Photographic Historical Society of New England.

Art holds the title of Honorary Member (HonNEC) and Vice President of the New England Camera Club Council (NECCC), recognizing his 18 years as Print Competition Director and commentator. His expertise spans macro and stereo photography, print making, and digital restoration, and he frequently serves as a judge and lecturer throughout New England and beyond.

# Hazel Meredith, APSA, HonNEC

Hazel Meredith is a passionate photographer and educator specializing in the creative aspects of photography and post-processing, particularly using textures and software to craft unique images. Since beginning her teaching journey in 2007, she has conducted numerous seminars, workshops, and webinars for camera clubs, conferences, and software companies across the U.S., both in person and virtually.

Hazel is also the co-producer of the internationally attended "Virtual Creative Photography Conference."

Her contributions to the photographic community have been recognized with both the APSA (Associate of the Photographic Society of America) distinction and the HonNEC (Honorary Member of the New England Camera Club Council) award for her service.



# Barbara Rozavsky, HonNEC

Barbara Rozavsky has been a member of the Greater Lynn Photographic Association (GLPA) since 1971, serving as past president, current membership chair, and presentation director of the Greater Lynn International Exhibition for over 25 years, earning her the status of Honorary Life Vice President in 2010.

Her leadership extends to the New England Camera Club Council (NECCC), where she is a past president, current Vice President, and previously co-chaired the conference Photo Ops Committee. An experienced educator, Barbara taught photography at North Shore Community College for over three decades and continues to teach workshops at GLPA and lectures and judges at other camera clubs.

In recognition of her significant service and promotion of photography, she was made a Master Member of NECCC in 1987 and received the HonNEC (Honorary Member) award in 2013.
